

Open the Finishlynx programme that you either already had on your computer or have just installed from your memory stick.

All the following slides if followed in the order as shown will enable you to access your event files, load and capture races for your meeting.

If the system has been setup correctly then the next screen will show you a list of all active cameras.

They may have been given names or Simply say "Camera 1" , "Camera 2" etc.

In this instance there is only 1 camera loaded and it hasn't been given any specific name, if at any time while operating the capture computer this line goes

Red immediately tell whoever you are working with and contact the start team and tell them to wait until you get back to them.

Red here means that the software has lost the connection to the camera.

Double clicking in the box that says "Yes" under the title "Capture" should instigate the software to re-establish a connection, if not then the Technician or Chief needs to be made aware of the problem and step in to resolve it.

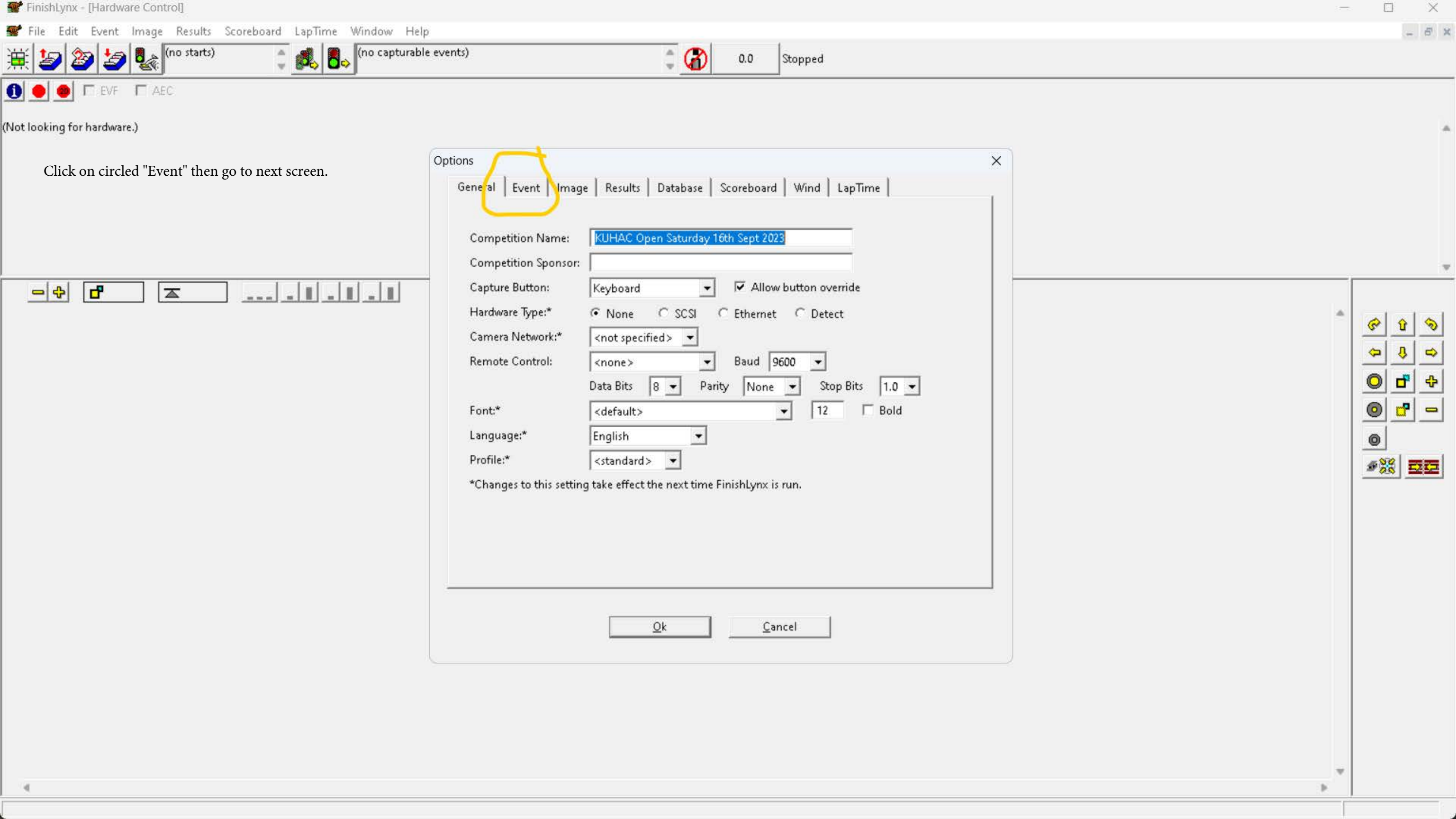




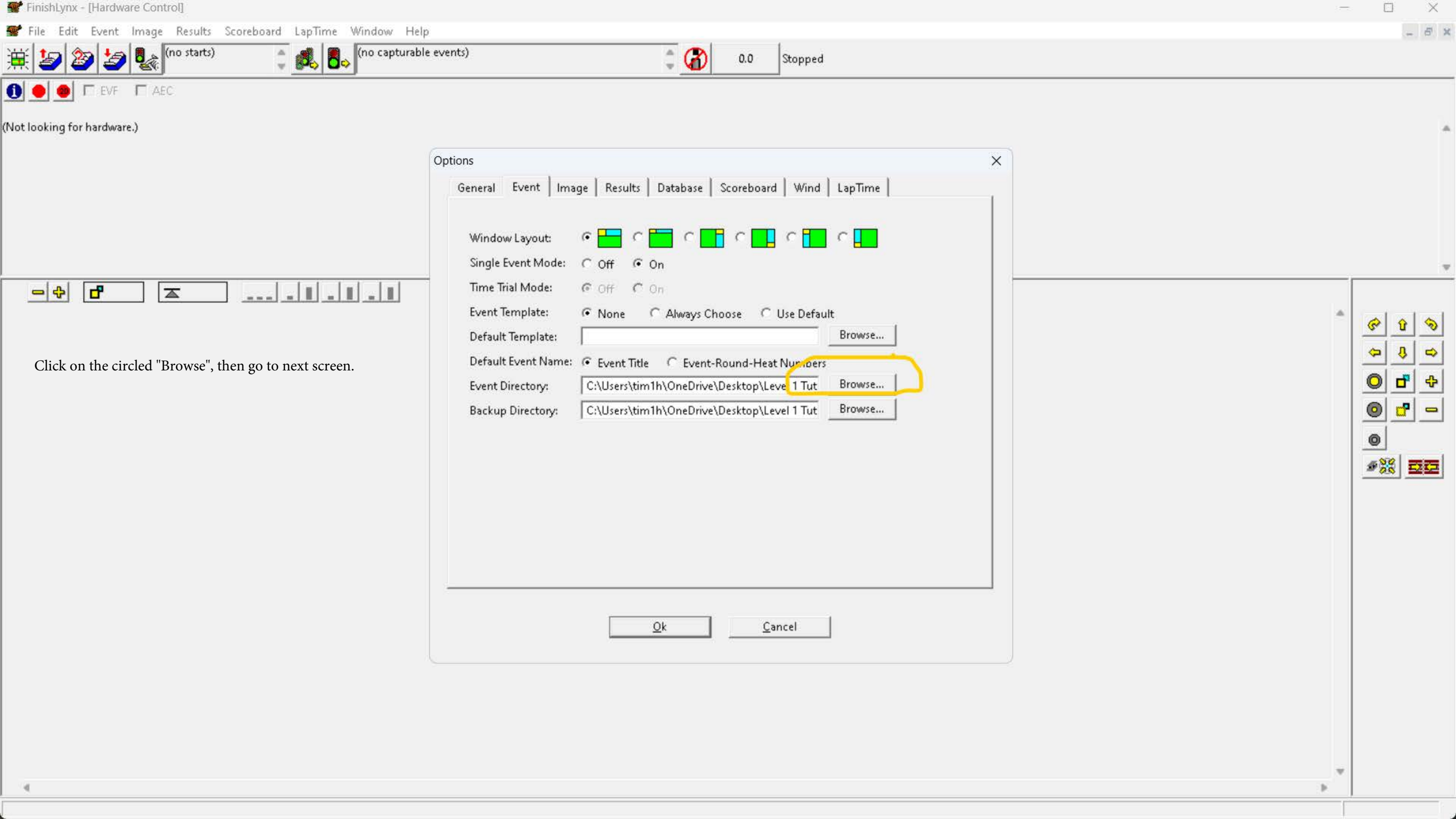
Click on the circled "Options" then go to next screen



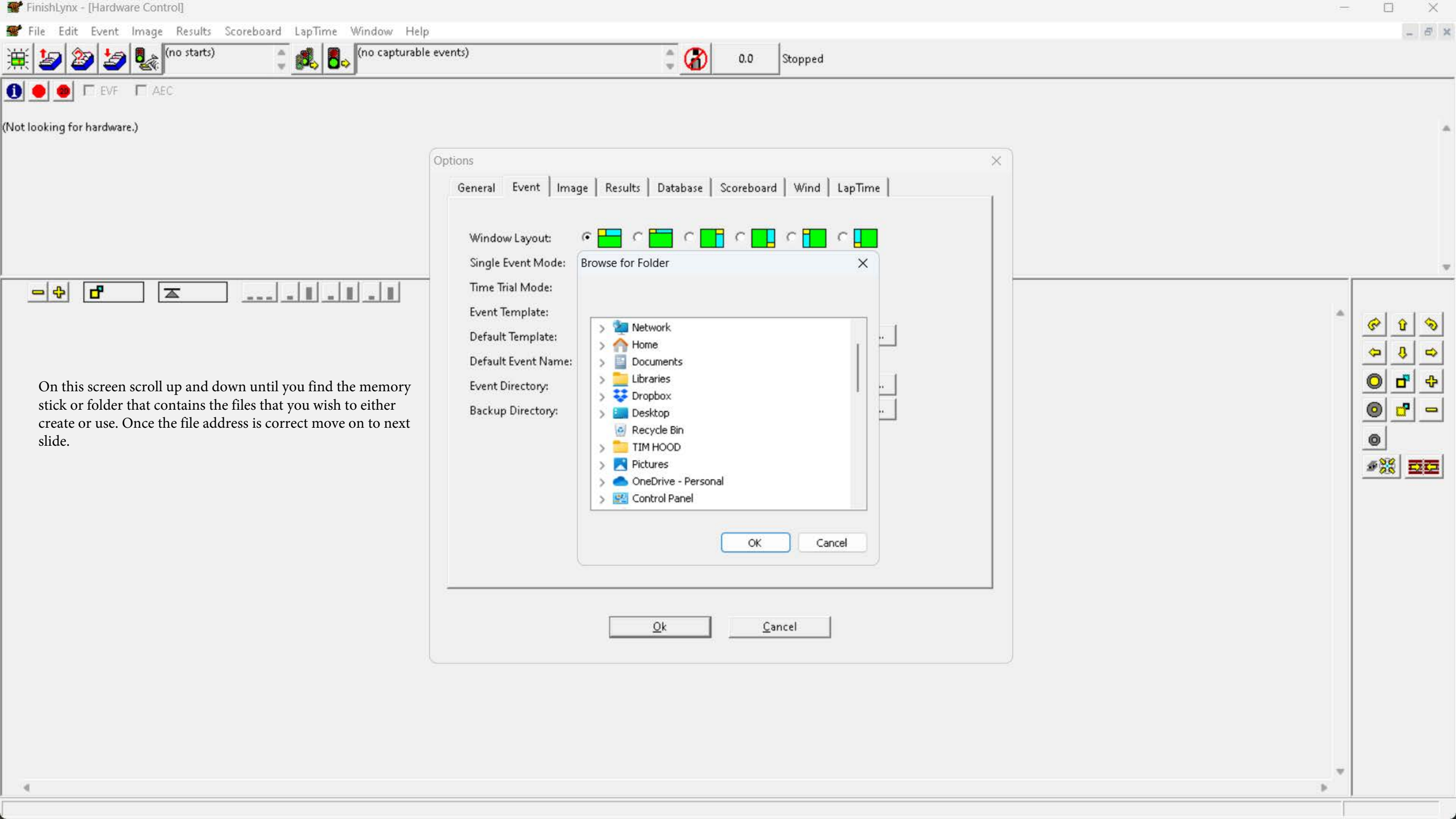
If you were setting up a new event you would put the title to be printed on results in circled box. Go to next screen



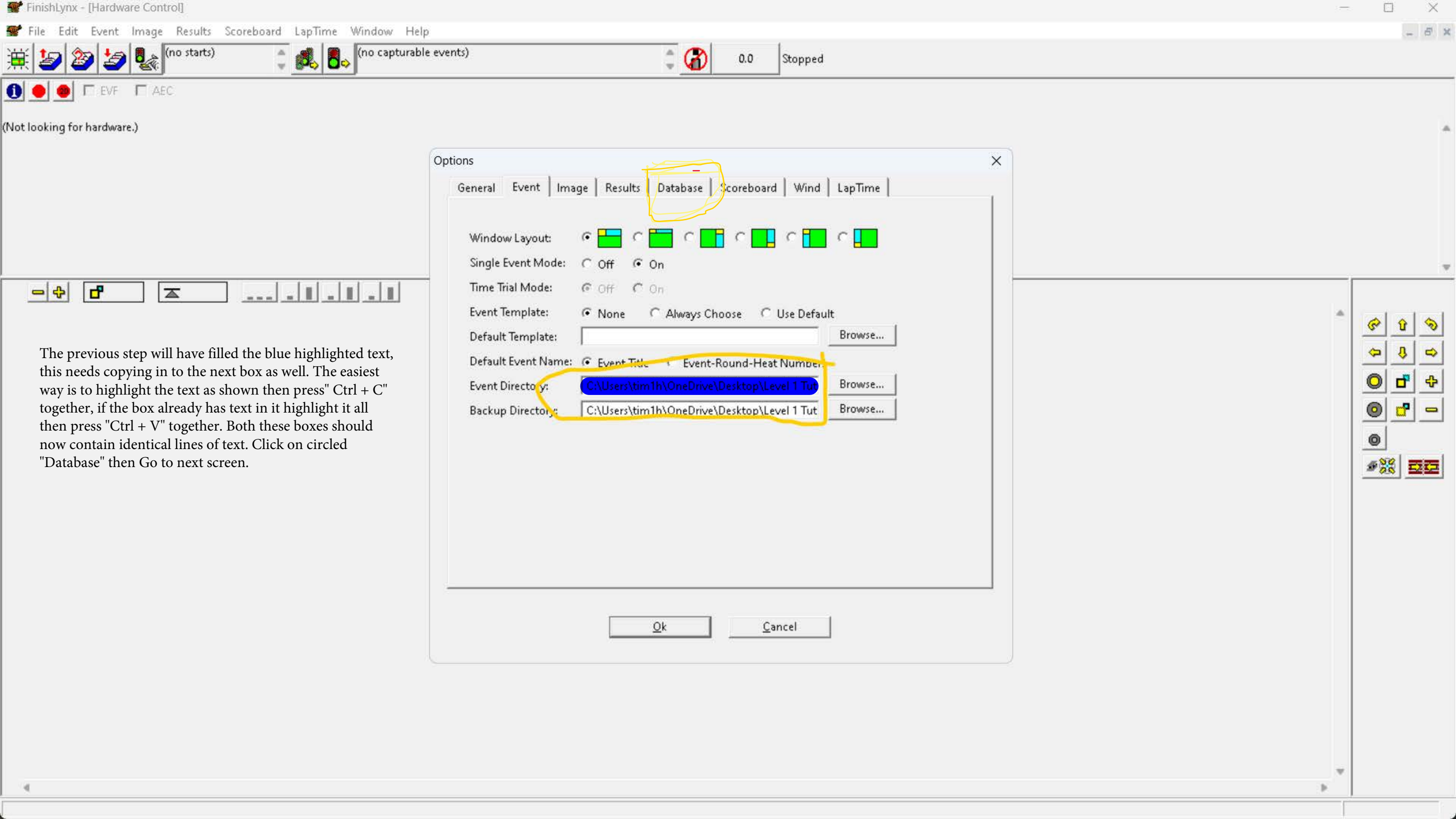
Click on circled "Event" then go to next screen.



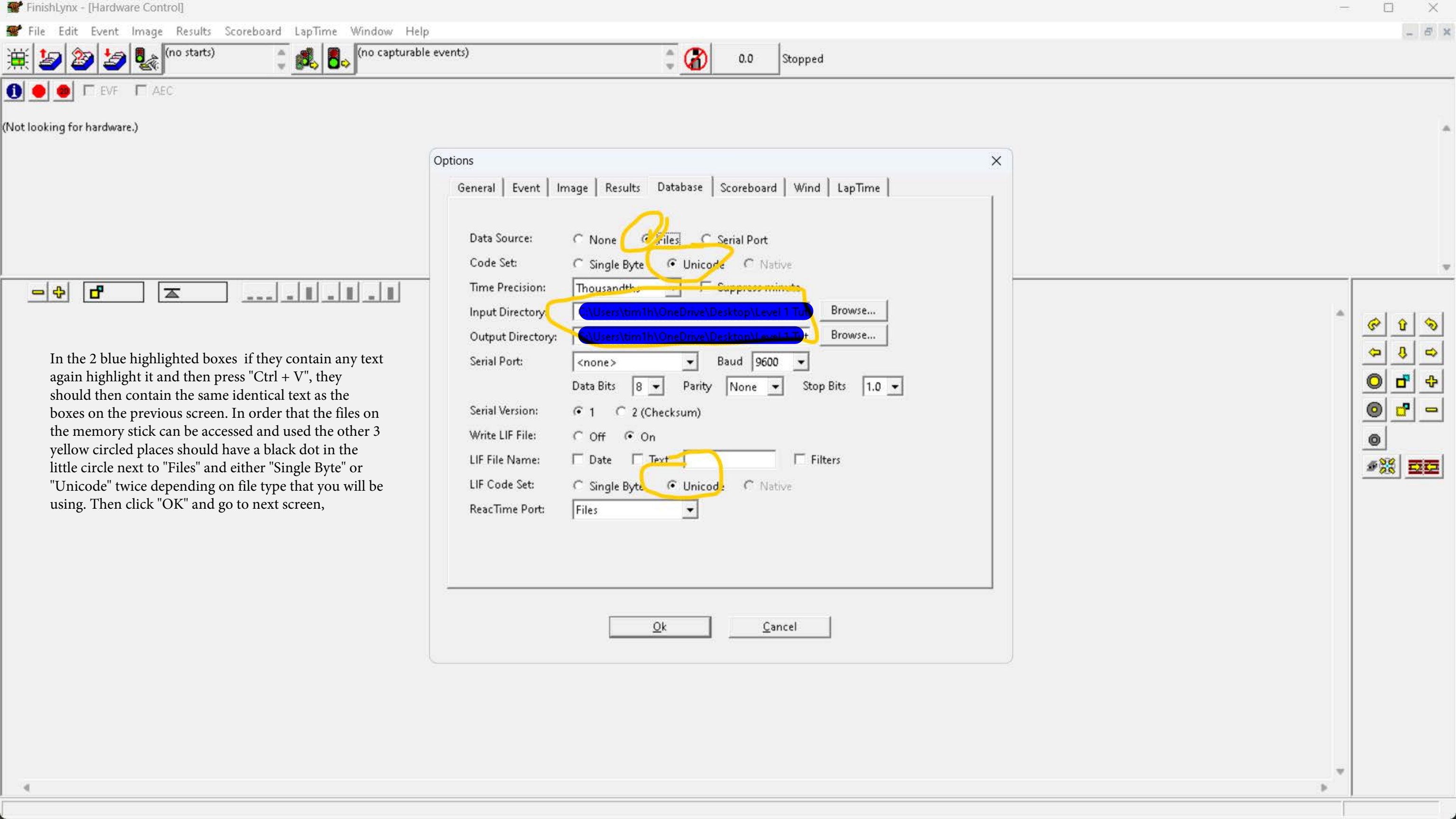
Click on the circled "Browse", then go to next screen.



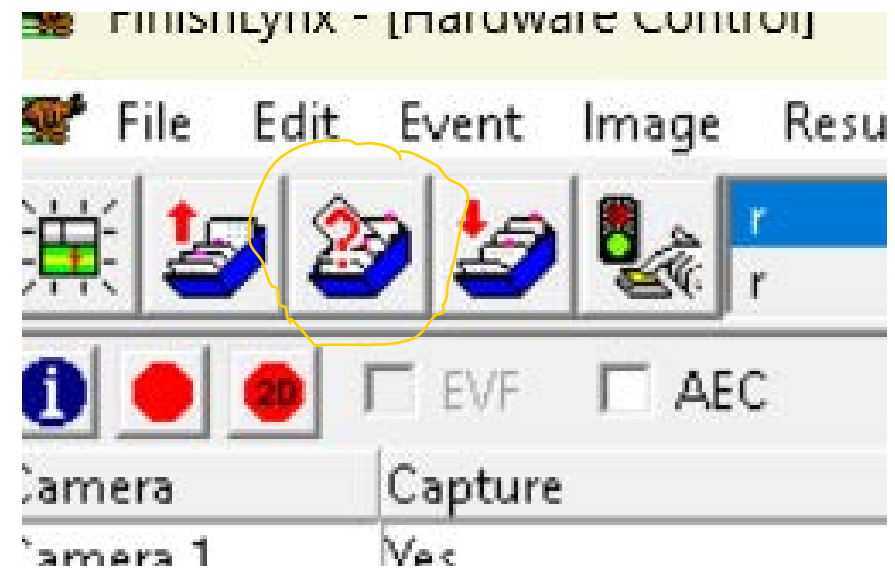
On this screen scroll up and down until you find the memory stick or folder that contains the files that you wish to either create or use. Once the file address is correct move on to next slide.



The previous step will have filled the blue highlighted text, this needs copying in to the next box as well. The easiest way is to highlight the text as shown then press "Ctrl + C" together, if the box already has text in it highlight it all then press "Ctrl + V" together. Both these boxes should now contain identical lines of text. Click on circled "Database" then Go to next screen.



In the 2 blue highlighted boxes if they contain any text again highlight it and then press "Ctrl + V", they should then contain the same identical text as the boxes on the previous screen. In order that the files on the memory stick can be accessed and used the other 3 yellow circled places should have a black dot in the little circle next to "Files" and either "Single Byte" or "Unicode" twice depending on file type that you will be using. Then click "OK" and go to next screen,



If you click on the middle of the 3 file boxes with a "?" in it circled yellow, then the following screen will appear.

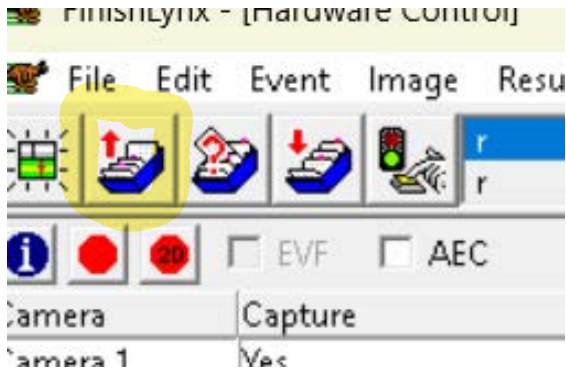


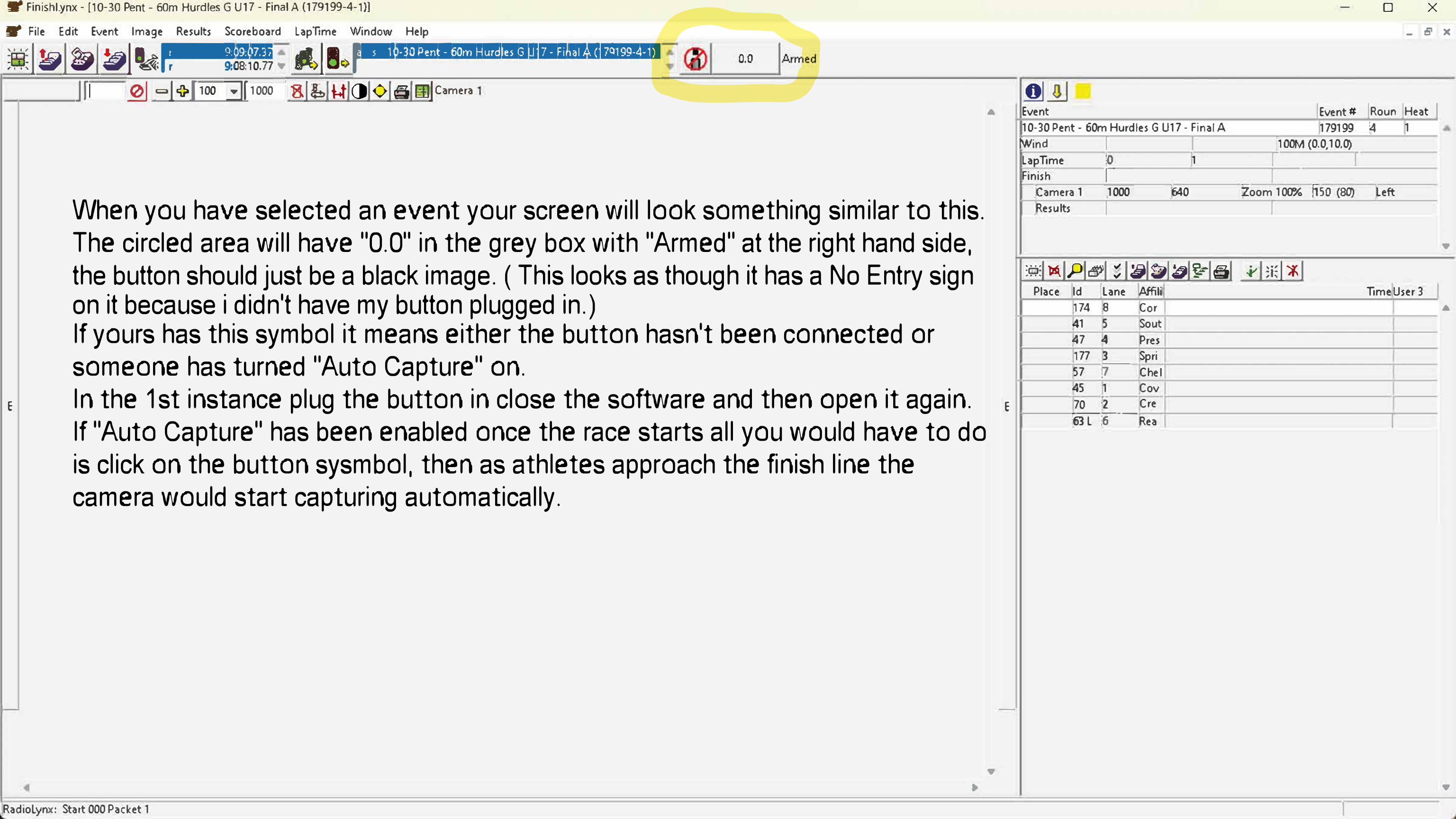

Once competition has started you would normally capture a race then save it and click the "Next" event arrow circled (points Down)



If they have run races out of order and you need to go back a race then click the circled box (points up)





When you have selected an event your screen will look something similar to this. The circled area will have "0.0" in the grey box with "Armed" at the right hand side, the button should just be a black image. (This looks as though it has a No Entry sign on it because i didn't have my button plugged in.) If yours has this symbol it means either the button hasn't been connected or someone has turned "Auto Capture" on. In the 1st instance plug the button in close the software and then open it again. If "Auto Capture" has been enabled once the race starts all you would have to do is click on the button symbol, then as athletes approach the finish line the camera would start capturing automatically.
